TOPIC:

THE PROPOSED TRANS MOUNTAIN EXPANSION PIPELINE

Trans Mountain is proposing an expansion of its current 1,150-kilometre pipeline between Strathcona County (near Edmonton), Alberta and Burnaby, BC. The proposed expansion, if approved, would create a twinned pipeline that would increase the nominal capacity of the system from 300,000 barrels per day, to 890,000 barrels per day. The projected capital cost is \$5.4 billion for approximately 980 km of new pipeline to be laid within the existing right-of-way corridor where practical, minimizing construction in new areas. The existing line would carry refined products, synthetic crude oils, light crude oils, while the proposed new line would carry heavier oils.

Mr. Greg Toth will provide an overview of this significant project which, if approved, is scheduled to be operational in 2017.

Presenter's bio:

A graduate of UBC with a degree in mechanical engineering and 25 years in the energy sector, Greg Toth is currently a member of the project's core leadership team working from Kinder Morgan Canada's head office in Calgary. He is responsible for all areas of the project planning, including submission of the Facilities Application to the National Energy Board (NEB). He is also responsible for engineering and construction of the proposed pipeline expansion. Greg

assumed this role in 2005 after completing two earlier phases: \$228 million Trans Mountain Pump Station expansion in 2007 involving the construction of 11 new pump stations, followed in 2008 by the \$543 million award winning Anchor Loop project, which installed 160 km of new pipe in Jasper National Park and Mount Robson Provincial Park.
