Port Metro Vancouver is Canada's largest port and is the fourth largest tonnage port in North America, responsible for Canada's trade with more than 160 world economies. Located in a naturally beautiful setting on Canada's west coast, Port Metro Vancouver is responsible for the efficient and reliable movement of goods and passengers, and integrates environmental, social and economic sustainability initiatives into all areas of port operations. Enabling the trade of approximately \$172 billion in goods annually, the Port generates an estimated 100,000 jobs, \$6.1 billion in wages, and \$9.7 billion in GDP across Canada. As a non-shareholder, financially self-sufficient corporation established by the Government of Canada, Port Metro Vancouver operates



pursuant to the Canada Marine Act and is accountable to the elected federal Minister of Transport.



**Mr Robin Silvester** was appointed **President and Chief Executive Officer of Port Metro Vancouver** in 2009. Mr Silvester is a Board Member and former Chair of the Association of Canadian Port Authorities, a Director and Chair of the Policy Council of the Vancouver Board of Trade, a Director of the Western Transportation Advisory Council, a member of the Executive Committee of the BC Business Council, and a past Board member of the British Columbia Maritime Employers' Association. Prior to joining Port Metro Vancouver, Mr Silvester served as Chief Executive for the property and facilities management business United Group Services ANZ in Australia. Earlier in his career, Mr Silvester served in senior roles with P&O Ports. Mr. Silvester is a **Chartered Engineer** and a graduate of Cambridge University; he also completed a Corporate Finance Program at the London Business School. After-dinner, Mr Silvester will speak on Port Metro Vancouver's vision and anticipated development over the next decades.
