A tale of transformation and teamwork under Canada's National Shipbuilding Strategy". The presentation will cover a couple of topics including: Seaspan Shipyard's history/pedigree; the National Shipbuilding Strategy, Seaspan's transformation story; what Seaspan Shipyards are building and how large, complex ships are built in British Columbia; some of the technical features and challenges; the critical importance of a learning organization; the socioeconomic impacts; our partnerships and supply chain; and the work Seaspan are doing to inspire and grow the next-generation of shipbuilders.



Biography

Mr. Russell Davison is currently a senior executive at Vancouver Shipyards, one of the most modern shipyards in Canada and North America. In his role, Russell leads a multi-disciplined team of planning and engineering staff who design, build and support large, complex ships for the Canadian Coast Guard and Royal Canadian Navy, under Canada's National Shipbuilding Strategy ("NSS").

In his previous role at Seaspan, Russell led the design of the Canadian Coast Guard's 88-metre Offshore Oceanographic Science Vessel, which is now entering the construction phase. Russell joined Seaspan as a seasoned engineer and business leader, with 15 years of experience in the defense industry on a variety of complex programs across the maritime, land and aerospace domains.

Russell is a Fellow of the Institute of Engineering & Technology and a Chartered Engineer. In 2011 he was the recipient of the Royal Academy of Engineering 'Rising Star' award.
