IMEchE	<p><u>Reduced fees for retired IMechE members</u></p> <p>If a member has retired from full-time employment and is over 50 years the annual subscription fee is £65.50 (regardless of membership grade).</p> <p>If a member pays an annual registration fee to the Engineering Council this will also be reduced as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chartered Engineer (CEng) £16.60 • Incorporated Engineer (IEng) £13.90 • Engineering Technician (EngTech) £8 <p>Please note, the Engineering Council fee is paid in addition to the member's subscription to the Institution. If a member is retired and has an income, including pension, of less than £10,000 a year, this member may qualify for a further reduced fee of £33.00</p> <p><u>Reduced fees for career breaks or altered financial circumstances</u></p> <p>The Institution can support members at all stages of their career. If your income is below or around £16,000 per annum you may qualify for a reduced subscription. If this is paid, the Engineering Council fees will also be reduced.</p> <p>For 2016, the fees are £16.60 for Chartered Engineers, £13.90 for Incorporated Engineers and £8.00 for Engineering Technicians.</p> <p>To apply, please complete the 2016 International Reduced Subscriptions Application Form and return it to the subscriptions team by email. Please include your membership number on the form.</p> <p>If a member is employed, then the employer's managing director, finance director, or HR director's signature will be needed to confirm that the details provided are correct. If unemployed, please tick the relevant box on the form and sign it before returning it to the subscriptions team.</p> <p>Ideally, forms should be returned by email, or post it to the following address: IMEchE Subscriptions, PO Box 87, Oakengates DO, TF3 3WT, United Kingdom.</p>

Retired any other grade (receiving <i>The Structural Engineer</i>) £65 3. Retired any grade (not receiving <i>The Structural Engineer</i>) £34 <p>Retirees choose the 34 GBP option and access <i>The Structural Engineer</i> on line. Retirees enjoy all the benefits of membership including visiting the Institution HQ when in London, plus access to Institution events and the library. ICE	<p>Retired ICE members are entitled to a reduced subscription fee, if they:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Were aged 60 or over on January 1, 2016; 2. Have retired from full-time employment on that date; and, 3. Are earning no more than £13,900 (approximately \$26,000) per year (excluding income from pensions) from any employment. <p>The Retired Subscription Rate for 2016 for members living outside the UK is £62.50 (approximately \$118) plus the Engineering Council retired registration fee of £16.60 (approximately \$31). For comparison, the current ICE Member and Fellow Rates for 2016 for those living outside of the UK are respectively £215.00 (approximately \$405) and £286.75 (approximately \$541), plus the Engineering Council registration fee of £36.80 (approximately \$69).</p> <p>To claim the Retired Member Subscription Rate, you can either:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i.
